With large ships constantly entering and leaving port waters, along with increased activities due to the opening of the Spoilbank Marina, it is up to you as a responsible recreational skipper to ensure you and your passengers remain safe.

You **MUST** stay well clear of the shipping channel and port activity, including bulk carriers, barges, and dredges, and only cross the channel when safe to do so.
