PORT OF PORT HEDLAND

The Port of Port Hedland is the world's largest bulk export port by tonnage, located on the traditional lands of the Kariyarra people. The port has a single entry channel which extends for approximately 40 kilometres and is impacted by a 7.4 metre tidal swing.




