Port users are advised that an HLV-Anchor pre-lay within the Port of Ashburton are in situ approximately in a 1000m radius around the Skate Mono Pod due to TVI - Decommissioning works. These are marked with light buoys.

A 1200m exclusion zone is to be observed around the Skate Mono Pod in position until this notice is cancelled.

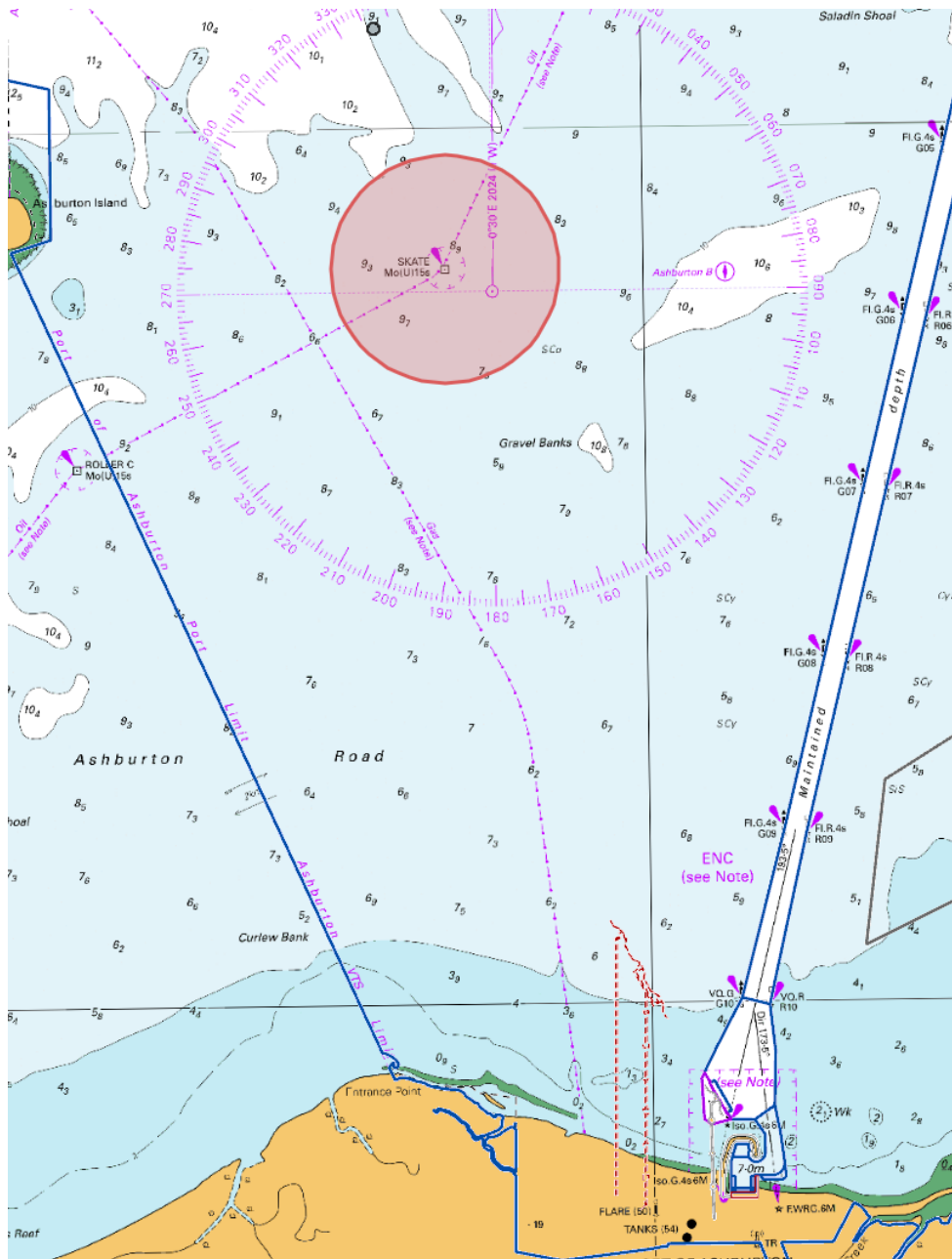
The decommissioning barge WB400 and support vessels will move from Roller A (outside of port limits) to Skate Mono Pod around 16th July 24.
