A 50m exclusion zone is to be observed around the waverider buoy.

Mariners and recreational boaters should navigate with caution in the vicinity of the buoy and stay clear of the exclusion zone.



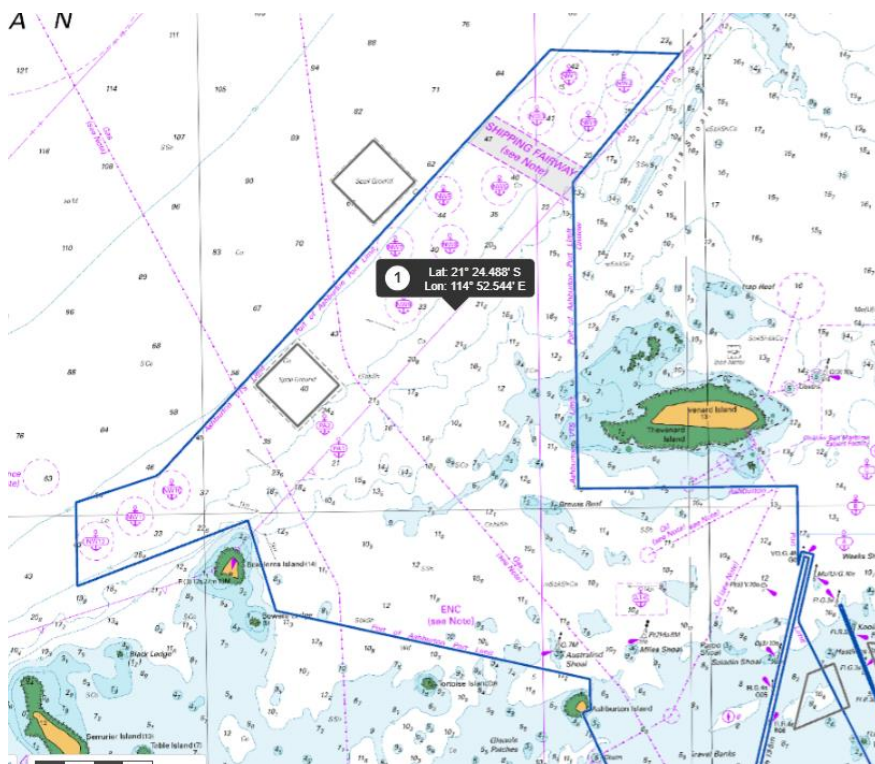
