**Light Characteristics:** Fl.(5) Y 20s (5 flashes in 10s; 20s repetition)

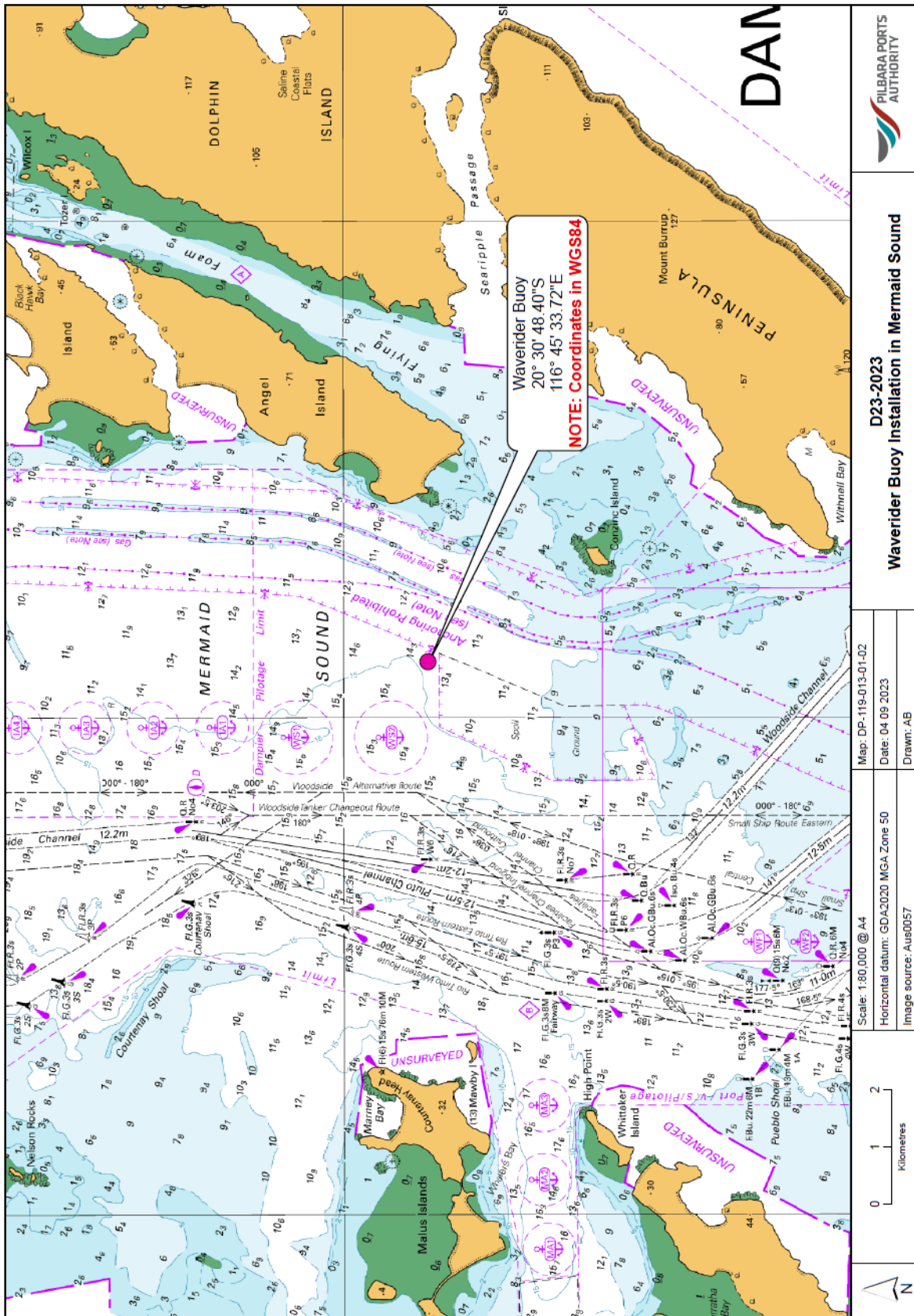
**Visibility Range:** 4Nm

Mariners are advised to avoid the area unless engaged in maintenance activities.

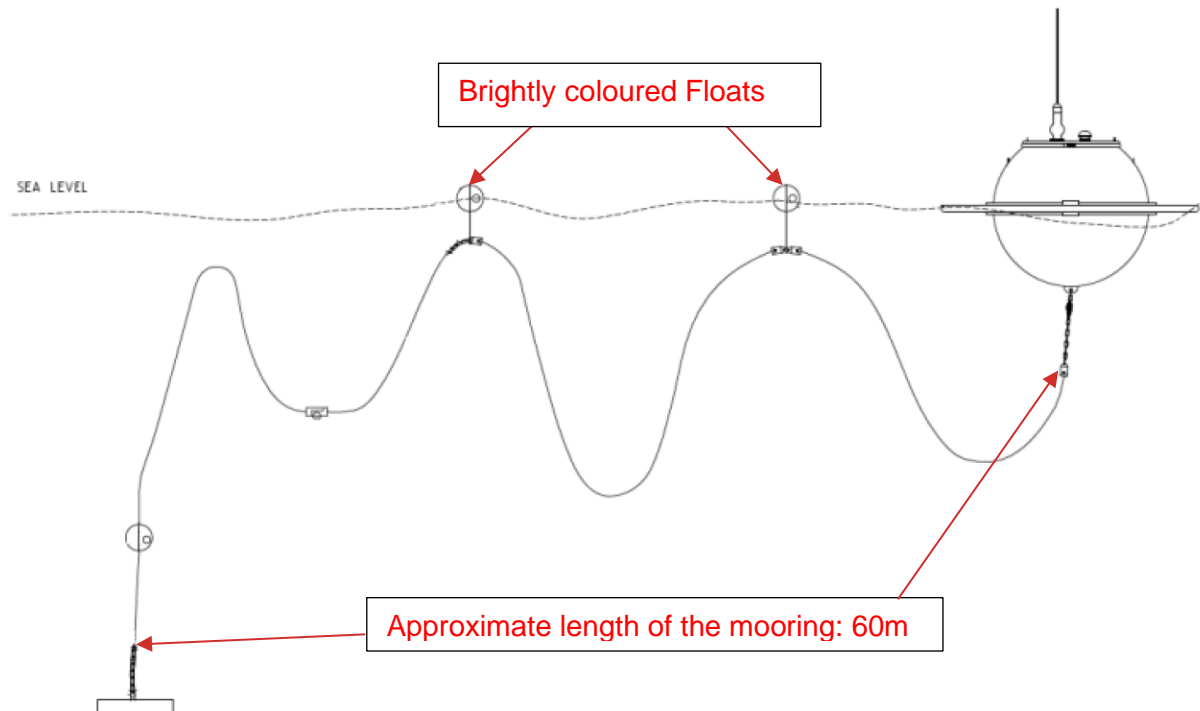
