Mariners are advised that a fireworks demonstration to celebrate Guy Fawkes Day has been organised at Hampton Harbour. The event details and the location of the barge from where the fireworks will be conducted are as below.

Date: 02 November 2024

Time: 19:00 – 21:00 Hours

Location: 20°39.90'S, Longitude 116°41.97'E

A Marine exclusion zone of 250 metres radius (shown in red below) from the above coordinates will be exercised during the abovementioned period. The exclusion zone will remain closed for navigation as well as swimming during the period of this activity.

A Sécurité message will be issued by the Dampier VTS, on VHF channels 11 & 16 prior to the commencement of the demonstration.

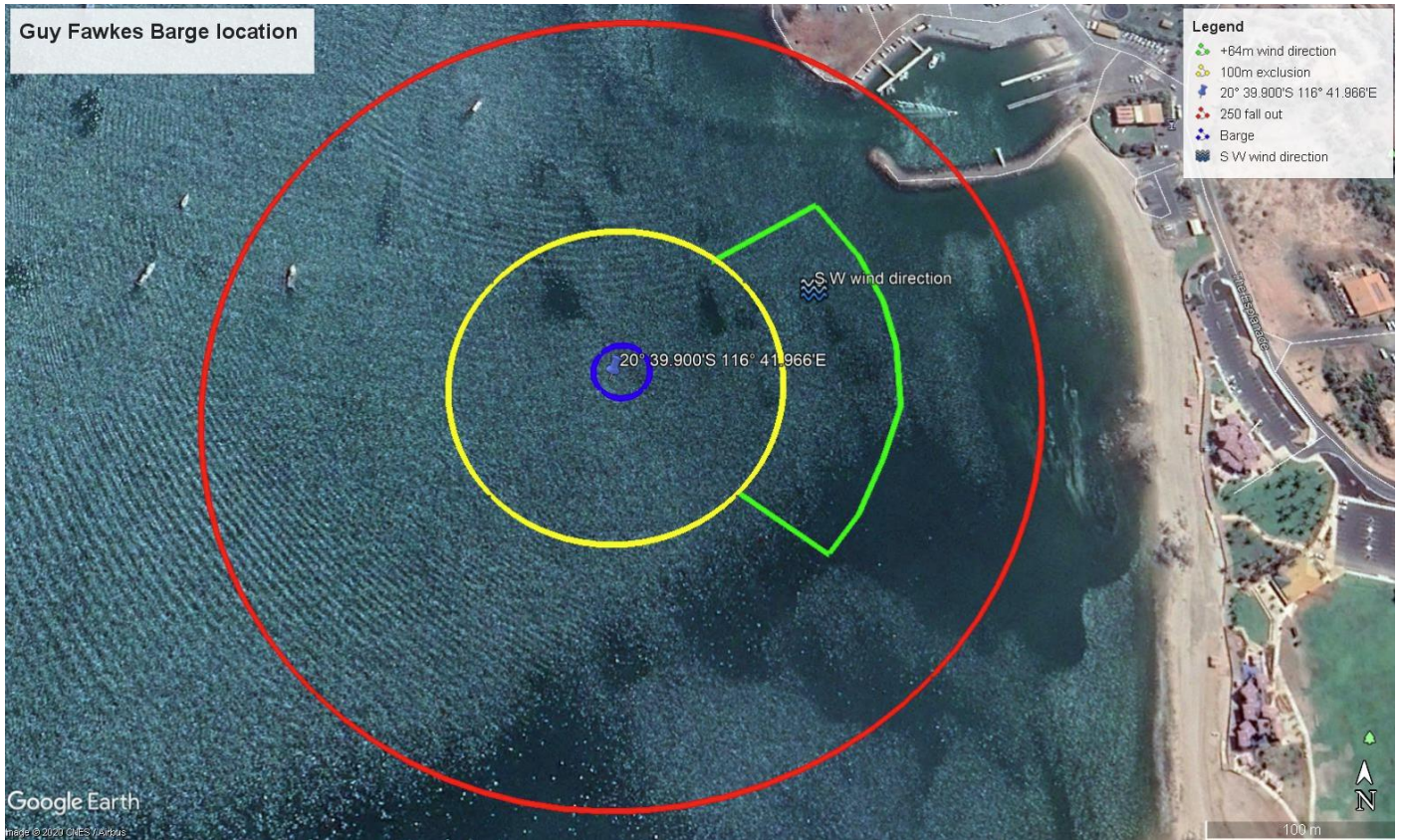
Mariners are requested to navigate with caution in the vicinity of the fireworks and keep well clear of the exclusion zone.
